



In 2016, Vida Verde served **767** students by providing our free programs to **31** classes from **17** underserved Bay Area schools.

92% of the students served are eligible for free and reduced-price meals in their schools.

99% of the students are ethnic minorities.

Due to cost, **NONE** would have otherwise had the chance to participate in a similar program.

the IMPACT we MADE

OUTCOMES FROM THE LAST FIVE YEARS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

96% of teachers reported:

A Marked Improvement (highest possible rating) in students' teamwork, self-confidence and personal responsibility.

89% of teachers reported:

A Marked Improvement in students' classroom learning and science test scores.

90% of teachers reported:

A Marked Improvement in students' awareness of and interest in environmental issues.

87% of teachers reported:

A Marked Improvement in students' overall experiences when they return to school.




